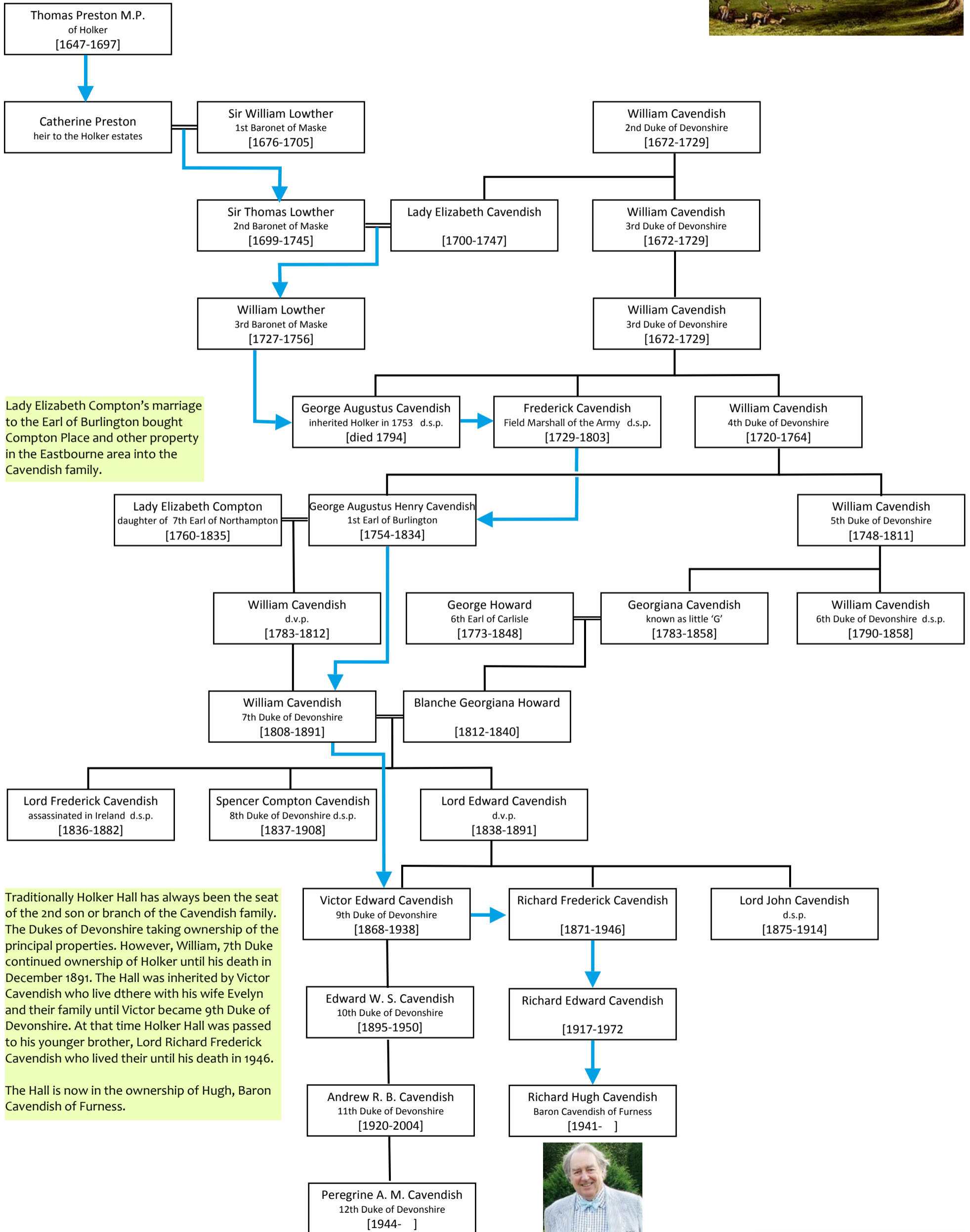


Holker Hall

Ownership Through Time



Lady Elizabeth Compton's marriage to the Earl of Burlington bought Compton Place and other property in the Eastbourne area into the Cavendish family.

Traditionally Holker Hall has always been the seat of the 2nd son or branch of the Cavendish family. The Dukes of Devonshire taking ownership of the principal properties. However, William, 7th Duke continued ownership of Holker until his death in December 1891. The Hall was inherited by Victor Cavendish who live dthere with his wife Evelyn and their family until Victor became 9th Duke of Devonshire. At that time Holker Hall was passed to his younger brother, Lord Richard Frederick Cavendish who lived their until his death in 1946. The Hall is now in the ownership of Hugh, Baron Cavendish of Furness.
